MARK LEVIN: We have Brent Bozell, the head muckety-muck of the Media Research Center, who monitors the media and is an iconic conservative figure. Brent Bozell, what do you make of this constant refrain from the Big Media, the corrupt media, every time there is some horrific, horrific murder or horrific event, they attack the right. They attack conservatives. They attack conservative media and so forth.

BRENT BOZELL: I think it's stunning because the cynicism is not to be believed. It's beyond that Kevin Bacon six-degrees of separation. They just immediately try to blame — you know, here are some examples. Number one, this is Chuck Todd on MSNBC. He said that Republicans are appeasers of White supremacists and now the chickens have come home to roost. This is *The New York Times*. They said the GOP stoked beliefs that led to the killings.

LEVIN: A couple of weeks ago, Brent Bozell, I explained the role of *The New York Times* in promoting Stalin, their correspondent in Berlin, who was tight with the Third Reich leadership, and how they also brought forth Castro. That's what *The New York Times* has done and how their ancestors owned slaves. I mean, none of my ancestors owned slaves, but in any event, how do you get from the Buffalo slaughter, Brent Bozell, which is horrific, to immigration? I mean, this killer was focused on Black Americans, African- Americans, that's why he went there. That's why he killed. He rejects conservatism in his writings. He didn't say he despised socialism. He said he's a socialist. He didn't despise the Democratic Party. He didn't despise MSNBC or CNN or *The New York Times* or *The Washington Post*. What do you make of this?

BOZELL: Well, you know, this just goes back to the politics of the Obama administration. They started it then and it has continued to this day, which is trying to divide America by race, trying to divide America by class, trying to divide America by gender. This is what they've wanted to do. This is how, by the way how Barack Obama won the election. Now this is how he did it. One of the ways to do that is to look for any — let me ask you this about White supremacists. They say that that the KKK has 4,000 members in a nation of 333 million. If CNN stopped doing documentaries on the KKK, it might just disappear for good. But Mark Levin, do you know of any White supremacist group? Do you know of anyone who knows of a White supremacist group? Do you know of anyone who knows of anyone of a White supremacist group? Where are these White supremacists groups that they're talking about?

LEVIN: Well, they used to be in the Democratic Party. The Democratic Party was aligned with the Klan. The Democratic Party supported slavery and segregation. The Democratic Party supported Jim Crow. Joe Biden supported segregation. Joe Biden was buddies with a full throated racist, and I could go on and on. The only ones I know of are on my website, Stormfront, that has a real hate on for me because I'm Jewish, and I think conservative and a constitutionalist. People need to remember, as best as I can tell, these Neo Nazis and White supremacists have something in common with the Marxists and the Black nationalists. And it's this: They want to

destroy America. They don't believe in our institutions. They don't believe in a civil society. They attack the Constitution. They hate Donald Trump. They hated Ronald Reagan, they hate everybody and so they all want to drive this country into the dirt.

BOZELL: One of the great haters in recent years was — do you remember the guy who almost killed Steve Scalise — shot him while he is playing softball on a field. Well, it turns out, this person is so radical that he despises all things conservative, all things Republican. And it came out that he was a fan of Rachel Maddow's, and it came out that he is a supporter of Bernie Sanders. How many stories were on that? Of the hundreds of stories that blamed conservative talk media for these vicious murders? If that is fair to do, where were the stories on this guy being a supporter of Rachel Maddow? Where were the stories on Gabby Giffords' shooter that they all said was a Republican and a conservative, it turns out he was a Marxist? Why doesn't anyone do any stories about say, oh, I know the leaders of Black Lives Matter are Marxist and therefore he is — what about the killer, the shooter in Dallas, Texas, who gunned down five police or nine police officers, shot them, wounded another 11. He said he was a supporter of Black Lives Matter. We looked at the stories, the stories came out and they showed the media backpedaling rushing to defend Black Lives Matter. Why don't they have the rules for the left that they have for the right? Answer: Because they want to do everything in their power to slaughter the integrity of the conservative movement, and anyone who supports America. Remember this, Mark? Why am I telling you? You just wrote a book about this. This is all about an effort to destroy America, and they're going to try to destroy anyone who loves America and defends America.

LEVIN: And you know, it's too bad, Brent Bozell that when Joe Biden went to Buffalo, he didn't give a speech that would unite Americans of all backgrounds and races, that he would talk about how we're the most diverse country on the face of the Earth, but the most united country, that's where we need to be, that a death is horrific, a death where people target people because of their race, their faith, their beliefs is a horrific thing in America, which is what we celebrate that is this diversity of thought and so forth. We don't have somebody who goes to these events and talks like that. We have somebody who only goes to certain events, and in my view, politically exploits them and we are at the same place we started before the mass murder. Nothing gets resolved. Nobody is tuning down the propaganda and here we are having to defend ourselves against this corrupt media and it is so corrupt through and through that people can say what they want about Donald Trump, I thought he was a fantastic President. But he sure as hell exposed the media once and for all with your help, Brent Bozell.

LEVIN: Brent Bozell's father was a brilliant writer and thinker, as was his uncle William F. Buckley, Jr. and he is carrying the baton at the Media Research Center where he does fantastic work. There is a pattern to this, is there not, Brent Bozell when it comes to the corrupt media?

BOZELL: Yes, this goes back many years. Some research that we did to prepare for your show, let's go back to 1995 and the bombing of Oklahoma City with Tim McVeigh and all the deaths that took place there. Time magazine said that conservative talk radio was, quote, "An unindicted co-conspirator in the blast." On NBC, Bryant Gumbel named, by name, Rush Limbaugh, Gordon Liddy, and Ollie North, all of whom had shows. He said: "While there's no suggestion that right-wing radio jocks approve of violence, the extent to which their approach fosters violence is being questioned by many observers. That just said that that talk radio had approved of the violence." Church burnings in the south in 1996. This is from *Time* magazine. "The torching of Black churches throughout the south punctuates the ugly rhetoric of the Buchanan campaign." It was Pat Buchanan who was responsible. The Holocaust Memorial shooting of 2009. This guy goes in there and he commits murder. Who did MSNBC blame? Yes, Rush Limbaugh. The Gabby Giffords shooting in 2011. Congressman Gabby Giffords was almost killed. Six people were murdered. Within hours, The New York Times, Paul Krugman had blamed Sarah Palin and Rush Limbaugh. And the interesting thing was, The New York Times said the link up to political incitement was clear. Sarah Palin's PAC circulated a map of targeted electoral districts that put Mrs. Giffords and 19 other Democrats under stylized crosshairs. Only one problem, that was false. It didn't happen. Not only that, it turned out that shooter was a Marxist who had done that. That story never came out. The Aurora, Colorado movie theater massacre in 2012. When that happened, Brian Ross went on Good Morning, America. And he said this: "There is a Jim Holmes of Aurora, Colorado page on the Colorado Tea Party as well." And then he said, "Now, we don't know if this is the same Jim Holmes." Guess what? It wasn't. The Colorado Tea Party had nothing whatsoever to do with it. LEVIN: Boy, it is so bad, and I don't know how a nation heals. I don't know how we become closer together when we have such a corrupt media. Let me ask you something, Brent Bozell, just as a universal point: Do you really see any distinction between the policies, the talking points, the politics of the Democratic Party and the main media? Any distinctions whatsoever?

BOZELL: None whatsoever. You know, and I used to ask myself, quite honestly, is that a bit of an exaggeration? It is not at all. The media are the tip of the spear. If the media weren't advancing these radical policies -- look at anything you want to look at. Look at Black Lives Matter. Where are the stories yet to be reported about the fact of the matter is that the leaders of these are self-proclaimed Marxists and their own manifesto calls for the destruction of Western civilization. These are not — it is not my speculation, just simply read the Manifesto. You won't see anything along those lines. Who will ever report the agenda of AOC? And what the AOCs of the world are trying to do? The fact that this is a continuation of the left's attempt not to bring

America together, but to rip America apart. And that this, at its very fundamental core, I've got to say this, and I'll say this over and over again, it is what you said — it is neo-Marxism in America. These are people who hate America. They hate what America stands for. They hate the American idea of liberty. They hate American exceptionalism, and they love what's going on to try to destroy America. That's all this is about, Mark.
