ED O'KEEFE: There are also notable congressional results in California. Congressman David Valadao is running second right now, but advancing to a runoff in a district now drawn to favor Democrats. He's one of ten House Republicans who voted to impeach former President Donald Trump and the first to face voters since then. Another Republican to watch out here, Young Kim, in her first term advancing to a runoff but currently trailing a democratic opponent in another redrawn district. If these two GOP incumbents ultimately lose in November, it's an example of how redistricting was used by Democrats to keep the Republican gains overall across the country smaller, potentially robbing them of a bigger majority in the House if they take control.

One other result out here in California to watch that was definitive — up in San Francisco, the district attorney, a guy named Chesa Boudin, recalled by voters. He's losing his job. He was elected in 2019 on a vow to reform the police, but high-profile examples of crime like smash and grab robberies and anti-Asian attacks inspired the recall campaign amid accusations he's soft on crime. Remember, most Democrats across the country don't embrace the defund the police movement or those more bold — bolder police reforms. Boudin did and residents at least in one Democratic city said they don't like it. Tony?

TONY DOKOUPIL: That race in particular may be a bellwether.
