[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: New Details on ICE Shooting Investigation]

SAVANNAH GUTHRIE: New details are emerging in that fatal shooting at an ICE facility in Dallas. NBC News has obtained surveillance video of the incident. The FBI is now saying the gunman did "significant pre-planning before that attack." NBC's Priscilla Thompson is on the story for us. Priscilla, good morning.

PRISCILLA THOMPSON: Savannah, good morning. Federal investigators are combing through electronic devices trying to learn as much as they can about this gunman who took his own life. At this point, investigators say that they believe he acted alone and the clearest indication of a motive that they have come from the shooter's own words. This morning, chilling new video appears to show the moment investigators say a gunman unleashed a barrage of bullets on an ICE field office in Dallas. The video shows shackled detainees running from transport vehicles under fire, bolting inside a building for cover, some seemingly stunned, others bloody. At one point, law enforcement can be seen carrying a person inside. The harrowing images come as investigators reveal new details about 29-year-old Joshua Jahn, the man they say was responsible for the deadly ambush style attack.

FBI SPECIAL AGENT IN CHARGE JOE ROTHROCK: Jahan specifically intended to kill ICE agents.

THOMPSON: No agents were harmed but a detainee was killed and two others were seriously injured.

ACTING U.S. ATTORNEY FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF TEXAS NANCY LARSON: He hoped his actions would terrorize ICE employees and interfere with their work, which he called human trafficking.

THOMPSON: Authorities say they found a shell casing at the scene with "anti-ICE" written on it, adding the gunman bought the gun he used in August and had been planning the attack for months. According to investigators, the also used apps to track the location of ICE agents.

DALLAS FIELD OFFICE DIRECTOR MARCOS CHARLES: It's no different than giving the hitman the location of an intended starring.

THOMPSON: Authorities have not shown evidence the shooter was affiliated with any specific group. [TO ROTHROCK] Was there anything in terms of an inciting incident that led him to commit this attack?

FBI SPECIAL AGENT IN CHARGE JOE ROTHROCK: In this case, the clearest indication of

motivation are his own words. He wanted to cause terror.

THOMPSON: But President Trump blaming Democrats for the violence.

PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP: The radical left Democrats are causing this problem and it gets worse. It gets worse.

HOUSE MINORITY LEADER HAKEEM JEFFRIES (D-NY): We need leadership coming from 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue to take the temperature down for everybody.

THOMPSON: And as for the victims, authorities have yet to publicly identify them. We're told that all of the detainees held here have been moved to a facility about an hour away and DHS says that they are increasing security at facilities like this nationwide, including this one, which is set to reopen on Monday. Savannah.
