TOM LLAMAS: New clashes in the streets of Chicago. Protesters facing off with immigration agents. This car smashed. Tear gas used to disperse the crowd.

LLAMAS: Now to some breaking news back at home and the new immigration clashes in Chicago. Tear gas deployed after crowds swarmed a crashed federal vehicle. Here is Gabe Gutierrez with the vehicle.

[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: Breaking News; New Clashes Over Illegal Immigration Crackdown]

GABE GUTIERREZ: Tear gas deployed after another clash in Chicago from President Trump's crackdown on illegal immigration. Homeland Security officials say an SUV carrying an undocumented immigrant trying to flee arrest first rammed a Border Patrol vehicle. Then, the Border Patrol vehicle crashed into the SUV to stop it. Chicago police say a hostile crowd started showing objects at federal agents, who then deployed tear gas. 13 officers were exposed to it.

CHICAGO DEPUTY MAYOR PATRICE PONCE DE LEON: There's absolutely no reason to have this kind of chaos happening in our communities, putting people at risk — [SCREEN WIPE] — just exacerbating the fear that people feel right now.

GUTIERREZ: The latest clash comes as DHS says Mexican drug cartels are now offering cash to target ICE officers and other federal agents. \$5,000 to \$10,000 for kidnapping or assaults on officers, and up to \$50,000 for the assassination of high-ranking officials.

TRICIA MCLAUGHLIN [on FNC's *America Reports*, 10/14/25]: We are not backing down. President Trump and Secretary Noem are going to give our law enforcement the resources they need to succeed in cleaning up America's streets.

GUTIERREZ: The President today, once again, touting his crackdown on crime in Democratic-led cities.

PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP: Chicago, we've already made a lot of progress despite fighting from the government. We'll — Chicago is doing great.

GUTIERREZ: Chicago Mayor Brandon Johnson is now refusing to play a video of DHS Secretary Kristi Noem at airports where she slams Democrats. Johnson calling the video propaganda.
