The brutal violence a reminder of everything the hostages had to endure. Families like this one overjoyed to have their loved one back home, but the recovery process is just beginning and the road will likely be long. Survivors describing abuse and malnourishment. Some spending so much time in Hamas tunnels, they now need sunglasses to adjust to the daylight. We begin tonight with a family grateful to have their son and brother back home, even as he warns, he has been changed forever.
