What we've learned about him this morning, as tensions in Minneapolis remain high. We're live there with the very latest.

[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: Happening *Today*; City on Edge]

GUTHRIE: We've got breaking news this morning out of Minneapolis. Congressman Ilhan Omar was attacked at a town hall last night with a man who sprayed her with some kind of unknown liquid. The assault, of course, adding more anxiety and tension to this already tense city. There are growing calls for investigations into the shooting deaths of both Renee Good and Alex Pretti. We've got two reports. We'll start with NBC national correspondent, Morgan Chesky. Morgan, good morning.

[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: Minnesota Congresswoman Attacked at Town Hall]

MORGAN CHESKY: Yeah, Savannah, good morning. And even with the news that some federal agents will be departing Minneapolis, residents here tell me they are still left absolutely fearful as to the uncertainty of what exactly will come next. And those feelings only fueled by what happened inside a Minneapolis town hall last night in a chaotic attack caught on camera. [SHOUTING] Overnight in Minneapolis, a man arrested after confronting democratic Congresswoman Ilhan Omar at a town hall, spraying an unknown liquid from a syringe.

CONGRESSWOMAN ILHAN OMAR (D-MN): DHS Secretary Kristi Noem must resign or face impeachment. [APPLAUSE] [SHOUTING]

CHESKY: President Trump, who has often publicly attacked Omar, telling ABC News overnight that he hadn't seen video of the incident, adding, she probably had herself sprayed, knowing her.

Omar posting, "I am okay. I don't let bullies win." And tensions are running high throughout Minneapolis over the Trump administration's immigration policies, with new details emerging about the death of 37-year-old U.S. citizen, Alex Pretti.
