GEORGE STEPHANOPOULOS: But we also know there were key election primaries last night, especially in Texas.

RACHEL SCOTT: Yeah. All eyes on Texas. George and Texas Senate Republicans are now headed to a runoff. Senator John Cornyn has held this seat for more than twenty years. He's facing attorney general Ken Paxton in a very close race and it has become the most expensive Senate primary race in history, about \$100 million in that race. Whoever wins will go on to face the Democratic State Representative, James Talarico. He defeated liberal firebrand, Congresswoman Jasmine Crockett. Talarico is emphasizing unity, really trying to appeal to moderates. Democrats have not won a statewide race there in Texas in decades, but Republicans know they do have a fight on their hands, George.
