SETH MEYERS [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Can't really hear you down here.

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: The five of us being here right now is obviously dangerous because we represent so much of late night. Jon Stewart is designated survivor tonight. [LAUGHTER]

VLADIMIR DUTHIERS: And call it team of rivals. Why the late-night hosts all appeared together last night. There they are. What is John Oliver doing?

DUTHIERS: Ahead, the titans of late night gather for one of Stephen Colbert's final shows and they had a lot to say.

[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: What to Watch; Late Night Hosts Join Colbert Show]

DUTHIERS: Hey! Raising the glass to the late-night hosts. That's where we're gonna begin this morning. Jimmy Kimmel, Jimmy Fallon, Seth Meyers, and John Oliver joined Stephen Colbert

yesterday as *The Late Show* enters its final two weeks on air.

NATE BURLESON: It's like *The Avengers*.

DUTHIERS: I know! It really is. It's like that scene —

BURLESON: Yeah.

DUTHIERS: — in *The Avengers* where they all line up, ready to go. And they did not hold back. Check it out.

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: I'm waiting for angry Stephen to come out. I want to see you go nuts, just kinda let loose.

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yeah.

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Let me tell you something. [CHEERS] You guys have no idea.

CROWD: Stephen! Stephen! Stephen!

[SCREEN WIPE]

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Each one of you, your shows are doing, each started before this show —

JOHN OLIVER [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yep.

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: And then you're gonna be here, after I'm here. [LAUGHTER] I'm like the — like, you're like the candy shell. I'm the nougat filling that somebody came along and just sucked it out.

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yeah.

CROWD: Awww!

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: And I feel like I'm — I'm being —

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: I feel like when your young wife dies, yeah.

CROWD: Ohhhh!

[SCREEN WIPE]

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: It's sad, it's what I'm saying, it's a tragedy to me.

MEYERS [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yeah.

KIMMEL [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Gone too soon.

JIMMY FALLON [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: I — I think it's odd the way it ended for you. I didn't —

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: I was quite surprised.

FALLON [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yeah.

COLBERT [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: And I'm quite surprised.

FALLON [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: And it's a bummer because I wanted to do this longer with you.

OLIVER [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: That's it. You're — you're talking in network television. It's odd, it's a surprise. As someone from a different area of television, I could say it was some fresh bull [EXPLETIVE].

FALLON [on CBS's *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, 05/11/26]: Yeah.

DUTHIERS: Because John can curse, it's on cable.

BURLESON: No doubt.

DUTHIERS: Yeah, this is really cool to see them all. I think Kimmel made the point that all of these shows combined get more viewers than *The Late Show with Johnny Carson* [sic] — *The Tonight Show With Johnny Carson*, which was one of the greatest shows in late-night history. The final episode of *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert* will air next Thursday, May 21, very sad.

BURLESON: Yeah.

DUTHIERS: End of an era.
