

I've Had It

Guess who was photoshopped out? Donald Trump. Nobody wants his fat ass, and his cankles, and his unathletic pink arm blob in a photograph with elite athletes. What do you think about that?

ANGIE "PUMPS" SULLIVAN: What? Are you saying he's not an elite athlete?

WELCH: Of course he's not.

SULLIVAN: You can't be saying that.

WELCH: Of course he's not.

SULLIVAN: Here's the thing. I'm no longer surprised that he wants to take every moment of happiness and celebration and make it about him. But the fact that he does it and he gets booed relentlessly, I just — I love that so much. Like, I had it on in the background, but when I saw they were getting ready to introduce Trump, I had to turn on the volume because it was Boo City. It was the best part of the World Cup, in my opinion.

SULLIVAN: Well, and it's — it's so disturbing. They're keeping from the public the damage of this war, and it is so ridiculous that he still stands in front of a microphone, and (A) talks about the nuclear — you know, we're getting rid of their nuclear capability. So, if they get one military outpost and they take it out, there's 50 — 100 others elsewhere that continue with the plan, and that's why — all of our bombs that cost tens of millions and hundreds of millions of dollars in the modern war — that Cold War idea of flexing, look at our technology, look at how much money we spent when we were in the Cold

War with Russia, that doesn't translate to a modern war where Iran has drones that cost in the thousands, and they have an infinite supply of them with assists from probably Russia and China, and we have to realize that the people that Trump admires the most in this world whom he will not criticize Xi or Vladimir Putin are allies with Iran in this.

SULLIVAN: Yeah.

WELCH: Like, they are sitting back saying, this is great, we're not having to do hardly anything to, uh, watch our enemy crumble, our adversary, which is the United States of America. And then over on Fox, Maria Bartiromo is so close to realizing that Trump is lying about the war. Let's play the clip.

MARIA BARTIROMO [on FNC's *Sunday Morning Futures*, 07/19/26]: SOUTHCOM says that there will be outsized action in retaliation, but I don't understand how it's possible that Iran has the capabilities to fight this way and continue to try to lash out at Gulf countries and US military bases because the U.S. has obliterated Iran's military, and the President continues to reiterate that.

WELCH: Yeah, it's because they're lying to you and that you live in this right-wing media bubble where you haven't read the same articles that she and I have read — that Pumps and I have read, that show that the military, the Pentagon has been saying for years, long before Trump was in office, when Benjamin Netanyahu would go to Bush, 1, when he went to — Clinton, when he went to Obama, when he went to Bush 2, and said we need to go to war. Iran is about to have a nuke. The Pentagon's like, here's the deal with Iran and their military. This will be a forever war because this is how they're going to fight. They don't have — you know, like, if you take out the Pentagon. Then we're decapitated militarily. Iran's military is not set up that way, and Republicans have such a hard time understanding anything outside of this lie that they believe in this American exceptionalism, and they just think, oh, if we go to war, we're absolutely, 100 percent gonna win that war. And the thing is like, did we really win the Iraq War? Was that a win? Did we win Vietnam? Was that a win? Did we win Afghanistan? Was that a win? No, we really don't.
