

I've Had It

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JENNIFER WELCH: Republicans have a new strategy for the midterms. Pop this up. GOP midterms strategy: “Make it a ‘hate election.’” And this is what I thought they’d always done, this is completely newsworthy to me. “Republicans admit the GOP’s midterms forecast is bleak,.
