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[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: 440 Noncitizens Voted in NJ Elections]

SHEINELLE JONES: Hundreds of non-citizens in New Jersey were able to cast ballots because of a software glitch. Governor Mikie Sherrill says a DMV software error led to more than 6,000 non-citizens being registered to vote when they signed up for driver's licenses or ID cards. 400 of them actually cast ballots in New Jersey elections between 2023 and 2024. The governor says there is no evidence that any elections were swayed as a result. The state is now in the process of removing all of those names from the voter rolls.
