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[ON-SCREEN HEADLINE: More Explosive Texts From Fauci's Phone Unveiled]

AINSLEY EARHARDT: So, there are some more damning news for Dr. Fauci. More emails are being released, more voicemails are being listened to, and text messages — There are 34,000 texts, and 522 voicemails, and a lot of emails from Dr. Fauci that were going to — that were being spread to experts in the business and the medical world, and Senator Rand Paul and Ron Johnson are pouring through all of these, and some of them are raising some red flags. There's this email on May 27th, 2021, from Dr. Janet Woodcock. She was the then-commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration. KILMEADE: So you just said, “Well, these are unrelated under — you know, there was underlying problems. That is not that significant.” So, they just dismissed all of it, and they would do some — they would start shadow-banning you or banning you entirely on social media.

EARHARDT: That’s right.

JONES: The sinister part about all of this, Ainsley, is that behind the scenes, they knew this to be true.

EARHARDT: Mm-hmm.

JONES: And look, I understand there is a massive debate right now about vaccines and what does the science say, and part of the reason people are tuned off right now and not listening to the medical professionals — it’s because of things like this, instances like this.

It’s from Latin America.

JONES: Which is illegal, by the way.

EARHARDT: It’s just — there were so many conflicts of interest, so that’s why we didn’t — didn’t trust him, and then we learn in January — January of 2021, he gets an e-mail from Dr. — or a tax from Dr. John Mascola, questioning about — should women get the — the vaccine? He says he was privately informed that the initial studies of COVID didn’t include women in the first trimester. He says — can we roll this back? Let me just read it verbatim what he said? Thank you so much. Okay. He said, “I am corrected on pregnancy studies.
